### **Keyera**

The Nordegg River Gas Plant - a decision was made to transition Nordegg from a sour processing facility to a sweet processing facility after the completion of the September 2022 Turnaround. The decision was made as a result of producer sour gas volumes being diverted away from the plant. During the September Turnaround, Keyera will take the opportunity to properly clean and decommission the sour processing equipment and make the required equipment modifications to facilitate the Nordegg Gas Plant sweet conversion.

**Notice of Cancelled hearing – Proceeding 410** - Shell Canada Limited and Pieridae Alberta Production Ltd.

The Alberta Energy Regulator (AER) has authorized Shell Canada Limited (Shell) and Pieridae Alberta Production Ltd.'s (Pieridae) (the applicants) request to withdraw the applications to transfer all licences and approvals for Shell's Foothills assets. Accordingly, a public hearing will not be held.

### **Liability Inventory Reduction Program**

The purpose of the inventory reduction program is to increase the amount of closure work occurring in Alberta, reduce liability, and increase the amount of land being returned to original or alternative uses. To do this, we are setting an industry minimum standard for annual closure work and encouraging companies to collaborate to increase efficiency of projects and complete more closure work. A program to nominate inactive infrastructure for closure will also be introduced.
