### **Written updates:**

#### **Bonavista**

Bonavista is wrapping up the in-line testing of its 2 new wells 16-20-038-07W5 and 15-20-038-07W5 in the Strachan area.

Drilling on the new 2 well Pad has commenced at 02-09-041-05W5 Willesden Green field. The drilling rig is nearing the completion of the the first well 01-11-041-05W5.

#### **NGTL Clearwater Compressor Station Unit C7 Addition Project:**

- Construction updates:
  - o Clearing and grading work is complete.
  - o Timber salvage contracts have been awarded to a local Indigenous community (Ermineskin First Nation).
  - o Construction laydown area and internal access road grading is complete.
  - o Earthworks and site grading for the main C7 footprint is underway.
  - o Pilot-holes and pile driving for both our brownfield (existing) footprint and greenfield (C7 yard footprint) area – is underway.

#### **2021 NGTL System Expansion Project (Brewster Pipeline Section and Nordegg Compressor Station Unit Addition):**

- We have launched [TC Energy's very first virtual open house](#) to support pre-construction engagement with communities across the Project footprint.
- Recently, stakeholders received a notification that we now face a 5-month delay on final approvals for the project.
  - o This delay means that selected pipeline components of the project face the loss of a construction season
  - o Some pipeline in-service milestones may shift by up to a year from Q2 2021 to Q2 2022.

- Further notification on construction and contracting opportunities will be provided when available, and Project updates will also be shared on our [www.2021NGTL.com](http://www.2021NGTL.com) and [www.tcenergyopenhouse.com](http://www.tcenergyopenhouse.com) sites.

### **2022 NGTL Edson Mainline Expansion Project**

- The project consists of two pipeline spreads:
  - o Elk River Section consists of 40 km of 48-inch pipeline located 115 km southeast from Hinton, AB, in Yellowhead and Clearwater Counties. Begins at SW 3-47-14-W5M and ends NW 20-43-12-W5M
  - o Alford Section consists of 45 km of 48-inch pipeline located 29 km west from Rocky Mountain House in Clearwater County. Begins at NE 14-39-10-W5M and ends at SE 3-36-7-W5M
- Below is the schedule of planned and completed activities:
  - o Q2-Q4 2018 – Initial Project Engagement began
  - o Q2 2019 – Filed a Section 52 application with Canada Energy Regulator (CER)
  - o The hearing is now closed and we anticipate a recommendation report by Nov. 26, 2020. That will then go to the GIC for review and potential approval.
  - o Q3 2021 – Subject to Regulatory Approval, commence project construction activities
  - o Q2 2022 – Anticipated In-service for all project components

### **NGTL 2022 (Raven River Section)**

- An application was sent in June 1, 2020 to the CER
- On September 23, 2020 we received information requests from the regulator and have since replied and sent out notifications to stakeholders for the filing.
- We are continuing geotechnical investigations and environmental surveys for the Project.
- Multiple council presentations have been completed with our municipal stakeholders.

### **TC Energy is proud to have participated in 3 Community Investment Projects in the area, including:**

- Crossfield Fire Department Turnout Gear
  - o The Crossfield Fire Department have recently brought on new members but didn't have turnout gear for the new members. Current members were already using gear that expired (they expire after 10 years). TC Energy wanted to help and donated the funds to purchase a new set of turnout gear. We believe in properly equipping all emergency responders.
- Rocky Mountain House Volunteer Search and Rescue Society
  - o Rocky Mountain House Volunteer Search and Rescue responds to numerous calls related to swift water rescue related. The team has 15 members, and all are certified a swift water rescue technician, yet they only had 5 sets of gear all of which were exhibiting wear and tear. TC Energy wanted to help and committed to donate the funds for them to purchase 4 new sets of swift water gear.
- Cremona High School Rodeo Association
  - o The Alberta High School Rodeo association who is hosting a 3-day rodeo October 2-5 at the Carstairs rodeo grounds. This event is involving students who live in Cremona, Carstairs, Crossfield, Koinonia. TC Energy has covered the cost of the medics for the event.
